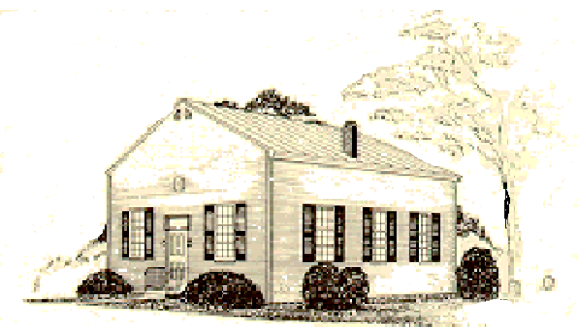
WELCOME!
