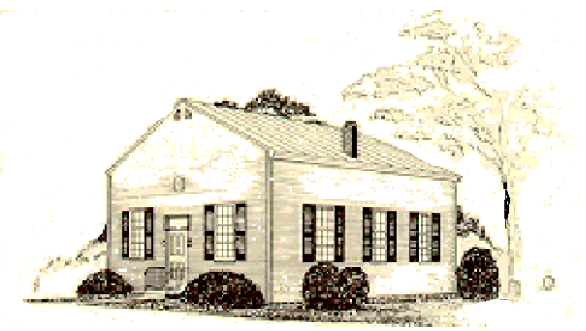
Hunger Awareness Week in Goochland April 21—April 27
