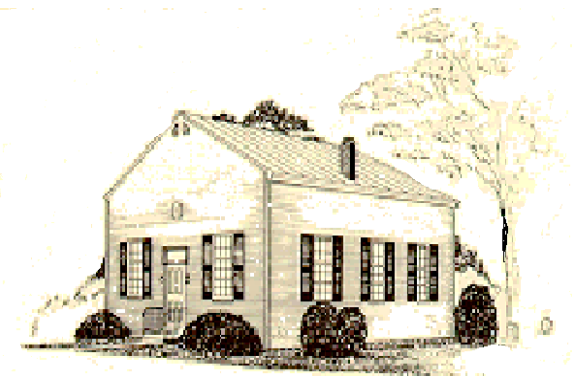
Following the service, please join us for fellowship and refreshments in the church fellowship hall.
