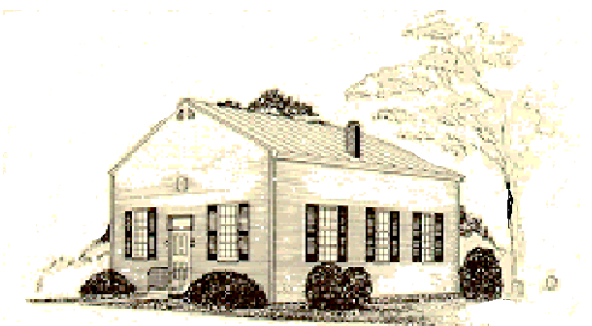
WELCOME!
