They will decorate the church beginning with the December 10th Tree Lighting Service thru the

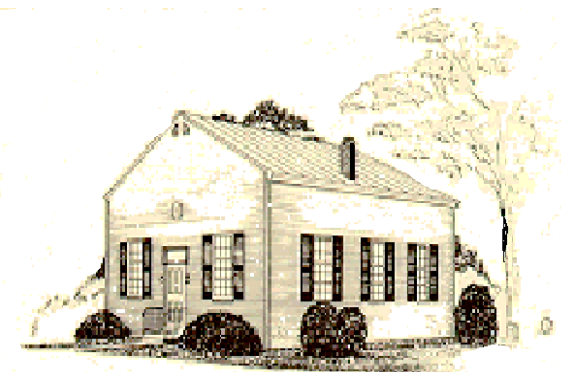
Christmas Eve evening service.
