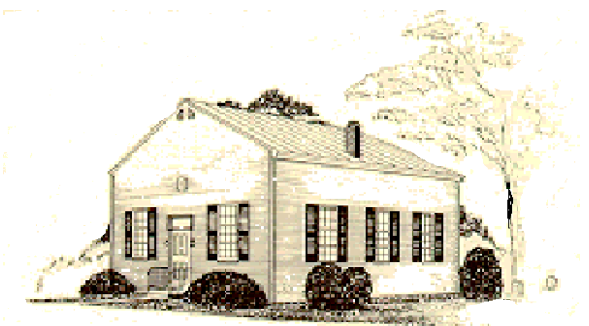
WELCOME!
