




Bible Story: Jesus' death and resurrection (Matthew 26:17-28:10)

### **Today's Craft Instructions: Colorful Cross**


- You will need: markers or paint
- A wooden cross is included in your To-Go Kit.
- Use markers or crayons to color the cross.
- Jesus died on the cross for you, to make a way for us to live forever with Him. Hang up your Colorful Cross in a place where it can remind you that Jesus' power lets us live forever.

### Today's Game: Cross the Divide

- You will need: a partner to play with you
- A beach ball is included in your To-Go Kit

### How To Play:

- Find some space to play outside. Stand across from your partner with a few feet between you. Toss the ball back and forth to each other. Each time you have a successful toss and catch, take a step backward and away from each other. Then toss and catch again. Keep going until you can't get the ball to each other anymore.
- What happened in the game as the space between you grew bigger?
- What was it like to reach your limit for getting the ball across to each other?
- This game shows us what sin the wrong things we say and do does to us and God. Sin puts an impossible divide between us and God. But nothing is impossible for Jesus! Jesus made a way for all our sins to be forgiven so the divide between us and God goes away, forever. **Jesus' power lets us live forever**!





# **Today's Family Connection: Resurrection Rolls**

Work together to make these surprising, tasty treats!

Prep Time: 10 Minutes Baking Time: 9-11 Minutes Ready In: about 20 Minutes Servings: 8

# Ingredients:

1 can refrigerated crescent roll dough 8 large marshmallows

1/4 cup melted butter 2 TBS ground cinnamon + 2 TBS sugar, combined

### Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

- 2. Unroll the dough and separate into triangles.
- 3. Place a marshmallow on the large end of the triangle. The marshmallow represents Jesus, pure and perfect.
- 4. Roll up the dough around the marshmallow and press the edges to seal. This represents the cloth that Jesus' body was wrapped in.
- 5. Dip in melted butter and roll in cinnamon/sugar. This represents the spices put on Jesus body.
- 6. Bake for 9-11 minutes until golden brown. While you wait, remember how Jesus was buried in a tomb.
- 7. Take out your treats and enjoy the surprise! The roll is hollow and empty, just like the tomb when Jesus rose from the dead. **Jesus' power lets us live forever**!

## Today's Outreach Idea: Share the good news about Jesus
