#### From Exploring to Experiencing God

This Fall we spent several weeks trying to answer some of the most difficult questions surrounding Christianity. This Winter we would like to move past the examination stage to the challenge of actually experiencing a day to day relationship with God. In Henry Blackaby's book and workbook "Experiencing" God", he posits the basic premise, "Find out what God is doing and join Him in it".



The idea is that God is already at work moving His agenda forward. The question is, "Do we want to join Him or attempt to create our own agenda?" The study begins first of all challenging us to believe in Jesus as God's Son. Without this belief it is very difficult to understand or follow the God of the Bible.

Blackaby sums up the Christian Life in "The 7 realities":

- 1. God is always at work around you.
- 2. God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.
- 3. God invites you to become involved with Him in His work.
- 4. God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes, and His ways.
- 5. God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.
- 6. You must make major adjustments in your life to join God in what He is doing.
- 7. You come to know God by experience as you obey Him and He accomplishes His work through you.

Beginning Sunday, January 8th, we will be offering Sunday School classes for all ages studying these concepts. The adults will be offered the opportunity to purchase their own workbook for \$13, do five studies a week and get the full benefit of the curriculum or you are welcome to come on Sunday and participate in the teaching and discussion. Either way I believe you will experience a significant change in your relationship with God.

#### Saturday, January 28 9:00-11:00am in Holman Hall

30 volunteers are needed to help package 10,152 meals! Volunteers will scoop ingredients into meal bags, weigh and seal the bags. Children as young as age 5 are invited to join us. We ask that children ages 5-10 are accompanied by a parent or other adult.



The meal bags contain rice, soy, dehydrated vegetables and a packet containing 23 essential vitamins and minerals. The meals are shipped throughout the world to support school feeding programs, orphanages, and crisis relief.

Stop Hunger Now distributes meals through feeding programs operated by partner organizations in developing countries that promote education, encourage children to attend school, improve students' health and nutrition, address gender inequalities, stimulate economic growth, fight child labor, and are part of the movement to address global issues.

## For God So Loved the World

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed.

But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God."

~John 3: 16-21

What does it mean to love the world with steadfastness and peace; to love in ways that don't condemn, but gather in, under a canopy of grace?


