Lack of education is a serious concern in Niger. The Evangelical Church of Niger has a reputation for providing some of the best education in the nation through a small network of schools. \$300 a year will send a child to school for an entire year. The schools continue to prosper and grow despite governmental turmoil after the 2023 coup. Hebron's continuing donations will help replace funding lost from French donors. After the coup, the schools continue to model Christian love and discipleship to the students and the community at large.

NIGER 2024 SCHOLARSHIPS



Hebron's Niger Child Education mission partners with the Evangelical Church of the Republic of Niger [EERN]. This partnership is facilitated by the Frontier Fellowship (www.frontierfellowship.com), a missionary organization that sponsors Christian missions around the globe. Niger is an arid country on the edge of the Sahara desert and is one of the least developed and poorest countries in the world. Christians make up less than 1% of Niger's population.





NIGER CHILD EDUCATION

For the past seven years, Hebron Presbyterian Church has been funding scholarships for children in Niger. When we started in 2017, scholarship donations funded 23 children. Since then, contributions have grown to support 60+ children each year. Last year as costs increased all over the world, we asked for \$300 per child to fund their schooling for a year. We were so excited and grateful that contributions still provided for more than 60 scholarships! We hope our past donors, as well as new ones, will once again be inspired to meet and exceed this goal. The harvest awaits!

We pray for the EERN's leadership as their officers work within the new societal order in Niger. Their faith and perseverance is an inspiration. We ask for God's blessing on their schools, students and staff in Tibiri, Dogondoutchi and Niamey. And God bless our scholarship donors!

THE NETWORK OF THREE SCHOOLS RUN BY THE EVANGELICAL CHURCH OF NIGER HAS ONE BOARDING SCHOOL AT TIBIRI AND TWO DAY SCHOOLS. HAVING THE OPPORTUNITY TO STUDY AND LEARN IS A PRECIOUS GIFT FOR THESE CHILDREN. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS CONTINUES TO INCREASE DESPITE NATURAL DISASTERS AND POLITICAL UNREST.
