## CHANGING LIVES



New elementary classrooms built in spring 2021

Lack of education is a serious problem in Niger. The Evangelical Church of Niger has a reputation for providing some of the best education in the nation through a small network of schools. \$300 a year will send a child to school for an entire year. The school in Dogondoutchi grew so much that new classrooms were required by the government. A donation from Hebron allowed two additional classrooms to be built in 2021. The short term goal is to provide a basic education for children.

The long term goal is to model Christian love and discipleship to the students, who will then go out into every facet of Niger society.

## NIGER 2022 SCHOLARSHIPS



Hebron's Niger Child Education mission partners with the Evangelical Church of the Republic of Niger. This partnership is facilitated by the Frontier Fellowship ([www.frontierfellowship.com](http://www.frontierfellowship.com)), a missionary organization that sponsors Christian missions around the globe. Niger is an arid country on the edge of the Sahara desert and is one of the least developed and poorest countries in the world. Christians make up less than 1% of Niger's population.







# NIGER CHILD EDUCATION

For the past five years, Hebron Presbyterian Church has been funding scholarships for children in Niger. When we started in 2017, a \$200 scholarship allowed a child to attend school for a year and we funded 23 children. Since then, contributions have grown to support 63 children each year. The need continues and costs, as they have all over the world, have increased. It is still amazing to think that \$300 will send a child to school for a year. We have so much and they have so little. We invite other congregations and individuals to join us in this ministry.

So many positive changes have taken place over the last five years. New classrooms have been built and the school population has grown exponentially. It is so exciting to see how these students have grown and flourished when given a chance to learn.



PROVIDING FOOD FOR HUNGRY STUDENTS IS IMPORTANT IN A COUNTRY WHERE MANY CHILDREN DO NOT KNOW FROM WHERE THEIR NEXT MEAL IS COMING. ONE BENEFIT OF THE \$300 SCHOLARSHIP IS AN INCREASED FOOD SUPPLY FOR THE STUDENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES.



THE NETWORK OF THREE SCHOOLS RUN BY THE EVANGELICAL CHURCH OF NIGER HAS ONE BOARDING SCHOOL AT TIBIRI AND TWO DAY SCHOOLS. HAVING THE OPPORTUNITY TO STUDY AND LEARN IS A PRECIOUS GIFT FOR THESE CHILDREN. THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS CONTINUES TO INCREASE DESPITE NATURAL DISASTERS AND POLITICAL UNREST.
